

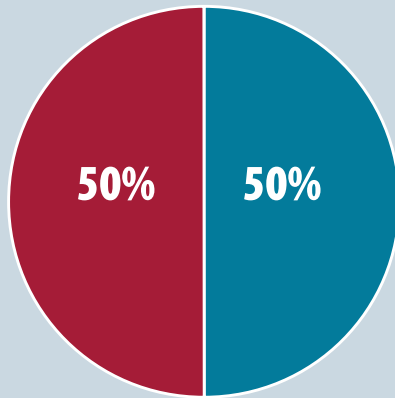

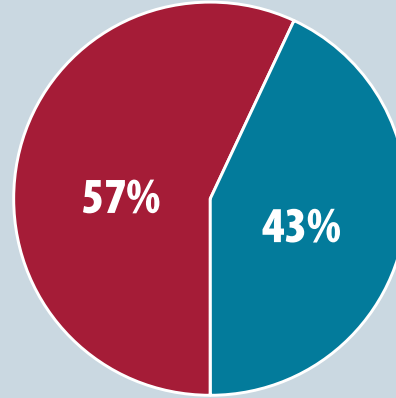
# Rural Road Traffic Crashes

Lack of sidewalks is the most common factor in crashes on rural roads involving people walking or riding bicycles.

■ Pedestrian struck while walking along road with no sidewalk ■ Other Factors



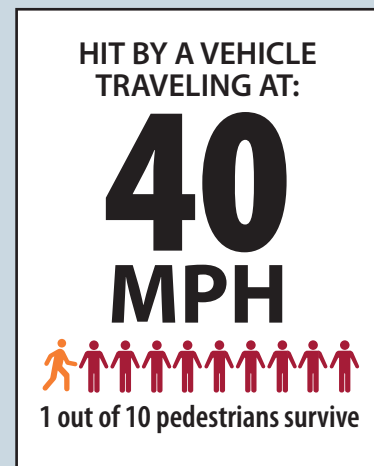

All information is from crash reports made by local law enforcement to TITAN (Tennessee Integrated Traffic Analysis Network) and analyzed by the TPO. The reports were made from September 2010 through December 2016 by the Blount County Sheriff's Office, and from August 2011 through December 2016 by the Knox County Sheriff's Office. TPO staff assigned crash factors based on information obtained from individual crash reports, including crash narratives and information about citations issued.
