Good morning Matthew:

We are so excited here at KAT. Things are just so great as we continue to pursue ways to bring amazing public transportation options to the City of Knoxville. I am sure you have heard Knoxville has received an award of \$3.6 million in FTA 5339(b) discretionary grant funding to purchase electric buses with charging equipment. This project is in the process of being added to the TIP.

KAT would like to make a request of TDOT to provide half the local match for this project, for a total state match of \$450,000.

We will need to make application in TrAMS so that FTA can issue grant award contracts.

We would then request match contracts from TDOT for the approved grant budgets.

Funding breakdown for the project as requested is:

35-foot Electric Transit Buses and Charging Equipment

TOTAL PROJECT = \$4,500,000
